Assembly Instruction

- Disassemble the unit by undoing the four fixing screws and remove the switch cover.

 Select the position of the switch in the cable, and cut accordingly to the
- Select the position of the switch in the cable, and cut accordingly to the dimendions in Fig1.
- Insert the two conductors into the first set of terminals, ensuring no bare wires are visible. Always tighten the terminal screws tightly.





Figure 2. - Wiring Guide

 Terminal are marked L + N for your convenience To assist with the correct installation see Fig2. Repeat for second set of terminals.
 A Align cables so they are positioned between the base screw locations.
- 4. Align cables so they are positioned between the base screw locations, ensuring the outer sheath is located on the ribbed area.
- Repace cover and tighten the four fixing screws. Upon full assembly the screws should be below the surface of the base.

Figure 1. - Cut Cable Lengths
