

Bathroom Lock

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE BEGINNING INSTALLATION


Tools Required:

- Drill
- 16mm drill bit
- Mallet
- Chisel
- Screwdriver
- Pencil
- Masking tape


1. Determine the latch direction according to door handling as shown in figure 1.

LEFT




RIGHT



2. Refer to figure 2, if the latch direction needs reversing.

- Position lock in mortice and mark around outer forend. Remove the lock and create a recess 4.7mm deep at the previously marked position.
- Insert lock into the door and secure with screws supplied. Determine the position of the strike on the door frame and fix as required figure 3 & 4.




PRODUCT MAINTENANCE AND

SAFETY: Please ensure that the operation of the lock and ensure that all fixings are secure and adjust them if required. These checks must be carried out every 3 months. Ensure that the strike plate/box keep is correctly in line and that the door has not dropped. Also ensure that the strike plate/box keeps are completely clear of any obstructions and that both latch bolts and deadbolts are clear to enter without problems.

WARNING: The safety features of this product are essential to its compliance with **BS EN 12209:2003**. No modification of any kind other than those described in these instructions are permitted.

For dead lock miss out latch reversal step (i.e.2), and step 1 not required.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS:

Keep lubricating with a lubricant after every 25000 cycle to ensure optimum performance.
