




INSTRUCTIONS

<p>Step 1</p>  <p>Place all parts on a clean and soft surface</p>	<p>Step 2</p>   <p>Attach the front and back Legs (③,④) to the Studs on the Chair Seat (②) using Washers and Nuts (A,B,C). Tighten the Nuts using the wrench & tighten.</p>
<p>Step 3</p>  <p>Attach the Backrest (①) to the Chair Seat (②) using Washers and Nuts (A,B,C). Tighten the Nuts using the wrench ..DO NOT over tighten.</p>	<p>Step 4</p>  <p>Attach the Right and Left Arm(⑤,⑥) ,using the studs (D) and washer,nuts (E,F,G) ,DO NOT over tighten .and then using Studs (H) and Washers and Nuts (E,F,G).Adjust to a correct place ,then tighten D&H.</p>
<p>Step 5</p>  <p>Adjust the pre-installed Rubber Pad (L) until the chair is level with the ground , Upon completion of full assembly and bolted up-all screws can be tightened down.Tighten all the nuts and cover them with nut caps(I&J).</p>	

WARNING

1. Do not discard any packaging until you have checked that you have all parts and fittings.
2. Ensure you have enough room for safe assembly. Ensure children and pets are kept out of the assembly area.
3. We suggest you carry out the assembly on a soft surface like a carpet or the opened box, so as to avoid scratching the paint.
4. Please note that this products is made of cast metal, you may find some unevenness on the surface which entirely normal for cast metal and is not a defect.

MAINTENANCE

1. Always lift and carry instead of dragging as dragging can cause damage.
2. Clean with warm water and a lint free cloth.
3. Do not use abrasive or corrosive cleaners.
