

GENERAL CLEANING & MAINTENANCE



General Cleaning

To keep the panels clean, simply use warm soapy water and a sponge or soft cloth. Rinse the panels with clean water and dry using a soft cloth. This will reduce the build-up of any residue and limescale.

Avoid using any abrasive cleaners including cleaners with solvents, scouring pads, wire wool or bleach as these will damage the surface of the panel.

To avoid water splash/water mark staining, buff the panels dry with a soft absorbent cloth such as a microfibre cloth.

Maintenance

Regular cleaning of the panels is adequate to maintain the look and water resistance.

We recommend that, if the panels are installed in a high humidity area such as a bathroom or shower room, that there is airflow in the room from an open window to reduce the risk of mould and mildew.
